Sub-Collector and Joint Magistrate, Salem. 1854: *Out of employ.* 1855: Deputy Collector of Sea Customs, Madras. 1859: *Proceeded on furlough.* 1860: *Returned to India*; Deputy Collector of Sea Customs, Madras. 1861: Collector of Sea Customs, Madras. *Died, 7th May 1861, at Madras.*

COCKBURN, THOMAS.—1779: Writer. 1790: Senior Merchant; Commissary-General of Grain and Provisions; Accountant to Board of Revenue; Register and Transfer Accountant of Debts of the Nabob and Rajah of Tanjore; Bullock Contractor. 1795: Member of the Board of Revenue. 1800: Second Member of the Board of Revenue. 1801: Senior Member of the Board of Revenue. 1803: *At home.* 1807: *Out of the service.*

COCKBURN, DAVID.—1796: Writer. 1798: Assistant under the Accountant to the Board of Revenue. 1799: Second Assistant under the Collector of Salem. 1801: Collector of Baramahl with District of Salem Kishnagherry, and conquered Territory lately under Major Graham's charge. 1803: Collector of the Western Polygar Pieshchush and of Arcot, north of the River Patar. 1804: Judge of the Zillah of the North Division of Arcot. 1805: Judge of the Zillah of Dindigul. 1806: Judge of the Zillah of the Southern Division of Arcot. 1814: *At home.* 1817: *Out of the service.*

COCKBURN, MONTAGUE DUNDAS.—1807: Writer. 1808: Assistant under the Judge of Verdochellam. 1809: Head Assistant to the Collector of the Southern Division of Arcot. 1816: Assistant Magistrate of the Southern Division of Arcot. 1820: Collector and Magistrate of Salem. 1829: *Out of employ.* 1836: Judge and Criminal Judge of Malabar. 1842: Judge and Criminal Judge of Madura. 1843: *Out of employ.* 1850: *Resigned the service, 16th February. (Annuitant on the Fund, 1850.) Died, 28th September 1869, at Kotagherry (Neilgherries).*

COLE, THE HON. ARTHUR HENRY.—1801: Writer. 1806: Secretary to the Resident at Mysore. 1809: Acting Resident at Mysore. 1812: Resident at Mysore. 1818: Superintendent of the Government Lotteries. 1827: *At home on absentee allowance. (Annuitant on the Fund from 1st May 1829.)*

COLE, ARTHUR.—1831: Writer. 1834: Assistant to the Principal Collector and Magistrate of Madura. *Died, 1st April 1835, at Madura.*

COLEMAN, GEORGE.—1790: Writer. 1791: Assistant under

the Accountant-General. 1792: Assistant under the Accountant-General to the Board of Trade. 1794: Deputy-Accountant to the Board of Trade. 1797: Assistant in the Export Warehouse. 1798: Deputy Accountant to the Board of Trade. 1800: Deputy Commercial Resident at Masulipatam. 1805: Commercial Resident at Masulipatam. 1806: Judge of the Zillah of Chingleput. 1816: *At home.* 1818: *Out of the service.*

COLLINS, JOHN.—1793: Writer. 1796: Assistant under the Commercial Resident at Salem. 1800: Deputy Commercial Resident at Salem. 1808: Commercial Resident at Maddepollam. 1809: *Out of employ.* *Died, 8th February 1811, at St Thomé.*

COLT, OLIVER.—1779: Writer. 1790: Senior Merchant and Postmaster-General. 1794: *At home. No trace after 1795.*

COMBE, HARVEY.—1804: Writer. 1807: Assistant to the Principal Collector of Coimbatore. 1809: Head Assistant in the Secret and Political Department. 1810: *At home.* 1814: *Out of the service.*

CONOLLY, HENRY VALENTINE.—1824: Writer. 1826: Assistant to the Principal Collector and Magistrate of Bellary. 1828: Head Assistant to the Principal Collector of Tanjore; Deputy Secretary in the Military Department. 1831: Canarese Translator to Government. 1834: Cashier to the Government Bank. 1835: Assistant to the Sub-Treasurer. 1836: Acting Additional Government Commissioner for Carnatic Claims. 1837: Cashier to the Government Bank and Assistant to Sub-Treasurer, and Canarese Translator. 1838: *Proceeded on furlough.* 1840: *Returned to India.* 1841: Collector and Magistrate, Malabar. *Assassinated, 11th September 1855, at Calicut.*

CONWAY, THOMAS BARLOW A.—1831: Writer. 1834: Assistant to the Principal Collector and Magistrate of Nellore. 1835: Assistant to the Collector and Magistrate of Ganjam. 1837: Head Assistant to the Collector and Magistrate of Ganjam. 1840: Head Assistant to Agent, Collector, and Magistrate, Vizagapatam. 1841: Head Assistant to Agent, Principal Collector, and Magistrate, Vizagapatam. 1845: Private Secretary to Governor. 1847: *Proceeded on furlough.* 1850: *Returned to India.* 1851: Sub-Collector and Joint Magistrate, Salem. 1852: Agent to the Governor, Kurnool. 1856: *Out of employ.* 1859: *Resigned the service, 1st August, in India. (Annuitant on the Fund, 1861.)*
